USQ Research

USQ has a reputation for excellence in its research endeavours and has been at the forefront of ground breaking research in a number of fields.

Agriculture and Agribusiness

USQ has undertaken vital research in agricultural productivity and environmental management in Australia and overseas to strengthen this important industry and overcome challenges.

USQ's focus in the agricultural field is to accelerate access to smarter, technology-based ways of increasing productivity, through to reducing costs and maximising the use of available resources.

Astrophysics

USQ has developed the Mt Kent Observatory to assist the global pursuit of finding and exploring new and near orbiting bright stars and exoplanets.

This work feeds into NASA's space mission '<u>Transiting Exoplanet Survey Satellite</u>' (TESS) by using our MINERVA-Australia telescope to aid new discoveries from the Mt Kent Observatory.

USQ astrophysics researchers also partner with the Harvard-Smithsonian Center for Astrophysics, the Carnegie Institute for Science and the University of Louisville to explore space for Earth's sister planet, and in the process, have discovered 40 new planets.

Materials Engineering and Engineering Technology

USQ researchers have collaborated with key industry players to develop and apply new composite technologies for construction materials and the repair of bridges, roads, railways and marine structures. Such work has resulted in cost savings to future-proof Australian infrastructure and provide long term use and reliability.

USQ Campuses

USQ offers free daily <u>intercampus shuttle bus services</u> between USQ Toowoomba, USQ Springfield and USQ Ipswich to give students more options and the flexibility to attend classes depending on their needs.

USQ Toowoomba

Toowoomba is one of Australia's largest inland cities and is located just one hour and 45 minutes from Brisbane and just over two hours from the Gold and Sunshine Coasts. With a total area population of approximately 150 000 (Australian Bureau of Statistics, 2016), Toowoomba is a thriving regional centre offering a diverse economy and the best of urban and regional environments. Toowoomba's relaxed lifestyle and family-friendly atmosphere is a great choice for students wanting relief from large city life whilst still pursuing their career goals.

USQ Toowoomba is the original university campus and is well equipped with a wide range of facilities and support services that caters for the needs of our students. USQ Springfield

Commission

USQ Finance will issue a Commission Entitlement Report after the census date of each semester. The report will be sent to the email address you have nominated to USQ. Your invoice should be generated based on the commission entitlement report. Agent Responsibilities

Advise students

Ensure students have all the information they need for their chosen program. Provide appropriate advice so they understand program requirements, visa conditions and career prospects.

Genuine Temporary Entrant

Ensure that students are genuine temporary entrants and will be able to financially support themselves (and any dependants) for the duration of their study.

Evidence of funds

Ensure that the students can provide evidence of available funds for their study and living costs. This information will be required for their student visa application.

Contact details

Make sure that you provide the student's home country address, telephone numbers and email address. This will enable the University to maintain important details about the student and use this information for legislative reporting.

Apply Online

Use our online application facility (OMEGA) to ensure you have provided accurate information and help us minimise delays in application processing.

Documents

Provide all required certified documents to avoid delays in application assessment (see Application Documents Checklist).

Acceptance and Payment Form

Complete all required sections in the Acceptance and Payment Form to avoid a delay in the Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) being issued. Ensure the students' signature matches their passport signature.

USQ Online Student Management System (OMEGA)

OMEGA is the Online Student Application Management System where agents should upload and monitor their student's applications.

A user manual and your OMEGA login details have been provided to you in two separate emails.

b. Please note that it is the agent responsibility to notify USQI if you wish to terminate any of the login accounts under your agency. You could do so by sending in the request to <u>io.marketing@usq.edu.au</u>.


Application Documents Checklist

The following must accompany an application to USQ for on-campus study to enable us to assess an application promptly:

Mandatory documents:

- GTE form, completed by the student, outlining why they have chosen USQ and this particular course, and how completion of the program will improve their career/future prospects.
- Supporting documentation (in .pdf format): Certified copies, with certified English translation where required, of the following:
 - award certificates for all formal schooling and post-secondary studies
 - \circ $\,$ academic transcripts for all formal schooling and post-secondary studies
 - formal identity papers, such as passport, national identity card, and student visa.
 - evidence of meeting USQ's English Language Requirements
 - proof of financial ability/genuine access to sufficient funds.
- Where applicable:
 - Where required for program admission: a detailed and up to date resume (C.V.) which includes date of employment, employers name and address, duties and verifiable references.
